

# **Trades Scholarship Application**

-2023-

The Township of Elizabethtown-Kitley established the scholarship in 2021 to commemorate the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the municipality and to provide financial assistant to residents of Elizabethtown-Kitley who are pursuing a post-secondary education based on a series of eligibility criteria. **The amount of the scholarship is \$750.00.** This scholarship is reoccurring, meaning the successful candidate can receive \$750.00 for each year of their studies provided they continue to meet the eligibility criteria.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

An applicant must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for the Township of Elizabethtown-Kitley scholarship.

- Must reside within the Township and be able to provide proof of residency.
- Must be attending or have received admittance to attend full-time post-secondary education at a recognized institution within the Province of Ontario.
- Program/area of study must be focused on the trades, in particular those specializing four sectors.   - ✓ Agriculture Sector
  - ✓ Construction Sector

- Awarded funds must be used for post-secondary education pursuits which may include tuition, textbooks, program supplies, specialized training and certification, or other related costs. The scholarship will be given directly to the education institution whenever possible.
- Submitted a complete application prior to the established deadline.
   The submission deadline is 11:59:59 p.m. of April 30, 2023. Details on how to submit are on the final page of the Application.

#### Notes:

- All information contained within the submission will be held in confidence.
- The successful applicant(s) will be invited to attend the Township's annual Business Luncheon, typically held in late-September/early-October, to be formally recognized.
- The successful applicant(s) will be expected to provide comments to be incorporated into a media release about the scholarship, which would also reveal your name, program of study, attending institution, and possibly photograph.
